



Dear Madam,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of 18th January, applying for a photograph of the grave of your son, the late No.3558 Private C.A. GAGE, 56th Battalion, and in reply very much regret to inform you that no report of burial has been received to date in this connection, and in the absence of official notification from the Imperial War Graves Commission, it must be reluctantly concluded that the authorities have not succeeded in locating the site.

Pailing the ultimate recovery and identification of his remains, the late soldier's name will be noted for inclusion on the memorial to the missing to be erected at Villers Bretonneux, France, and at a later date the opportunity will be afforded relatives of obtaining a copy of the printed Register containing full particulars of those commemorated in this manner.

No personal effects of your son have been returned to this office, and in view of the length of time that has elapsed since his death, it is considered improbable that any were recovered at the time.

Regarding the latter part of your letter, I have referred an extract to the Secretary, A.I.F. Canteens Funds Trust, Victoria Barracks, Melbourne, who will reply direct to your application for monetary assistance.
