Quinn was, I think, in "D" Company: I did not know him personally, but whilst I was looking for the graves of men in my Company "C", of which I was Clerk, I remember finding the grave of J.J.Quinn. This wasjust in front of Hamel on 8/8/1918, about 6 of them were buried together. When I saw it there was just a stick with their names on pieces of wood; they had just been buried by the 10th Brigade. I saw his grave on 10/8/1918.
