Whilst this Battalion was attacking PERONNE on the 1st inst an enemy machine gume post was concentrating heavy fire on the centre of our Company sector.

Cpl. Buckley with one private rushed the post

On reaching the most at \$349*** PERONNE we were held up by heavy Fachine gun fire concentrated on bridge. Whilst recommoitring the position to find another crossing he met his death.

Throughout the whole attack he showed great coolness and presence of mind also leadership, his whole heart being set on the success of the operation.

He with great coolness and presence of mind rushed the post capturing the jum and about 20 men. When near the meat surrounding the city wey were held up on the bridge by machine gum fire, Opt Buckley seeing that trying to cross the bridge was impossible went round the bank to the right to find another crossing and there met his death. It was largely due to his conduct that his section was able to advance like it did during the operations.
