In reply to your communication of 15th inst., I have to state no advice has been received at this office to date, to the effect that your son, the late No. 1876 Corpl. A. H. Buckley, 54th pattalion, was awarded a Victoria Cross. Should such information be received you will be promptly advised. It is pointed out that reports of this nature are frequently some time in coming to hand, as the ddvice is not cabled, but is included in records forwarded from overseas by mail.

As regards a record of your late son's military doingd, it is suggested that a preparation of this be postponed in order that the award of the Victoria Cross may be included therein, if the advice you have received be correct.

No personal effects have been returned to date, but anything coming to hand will be transmitted to you in the absence of any testamentary directions prescribing otherwise. The Medalation will also be forwarded to you under the same conditions.
