Some of the animals were shot down aprij. as soon as loaded and he had their loads shifted to other a finals and sent them away. The work was almost completed when unfortunately Capt HOULE was wounded. energy & It was only by his/fearlessness that the front line was kept well supplied 20.0., 13th Aust Inf Bde. throughout the tour under edverse weather conditions in this badly shelled sector.llujor Gen.
