A Funeral Service for Two Unknown Soldiers of the Royal Scots And an Unknown Soldier of an Unknown Regiment, Killed in Action during the Great War

1030 hours Wednesday 28 March 2018

St Mary's A.D.S. Cemetery, Haisnes

The remains of two unknown British soldiers of the Great War were discovered by a farmer near to Haisnes. Shoulder titles found with the remains indicate that these were soldiers of the Royal Scots. Given the location of where the remains were found it is a possibility that these soldiers were killed during the Battle of Loos in September 1915. However there are unfortunately still too many soldiers of the Royal Scots missing from that battle to identify these soldiers. They will therefore be buried today as unknown soldiers of the Royal Scots.

Today an unknown soldier of an unknown regiment will also be laid to rest. His remains were found by a farmer near to the former Hohenzollern Redoubt, a German defensive position which was fought over several times. No regimental insignia were found with the remains and so identification has unfortunately not been possible.

Les restes de deux soldats Britanniques de la Grande Guerre ont était découverts par un fermier près d'Haisnes. Les titres d'épaules qui ont était trouvés avec les restes dénotent qu'ils étaient deux soldats du Royal Scots. Étant donné le lieu où les restes ont était trouvés, il y a une possibilité que ces soldats étaient tués en Septembre 1915 au cours de la Bataille de Loos. Cependant il y avait un trop grand nombre des soldats du Royal Scots qui ont était tués pendant cette époque et qui manquent encore pour tenter d'identifier ces hommes. Ils seront donc inhumés comme des soldats inconnus du Royal Scots.

Aujourd'hui un soldat inconnu d'un régiment inconnu va être enterré aussi. Les restes ont été découverts par un fermier près de la Redoute Hohenzollern, un renforcement Allemand qui était l'objet de combats à plusieurs fois. Rien des insignes régimentaires ont était trouvés avec les restes et désormais l'identification n'a pas été possible.
