Record of Service Detail

2 February 1916	Enlisted in 1 st MB at Ballarat, Victoria
22 July 1916	Embarked at Melbourne on HMV <i>Chamblough</i>
11 August 1916	Re-embarked Fremantle, WA
01 August 1916	Marched into 2 Training Battalion
12 March 1917	Attached to Australian Flying Corps (AFC) HQ for temporary duty
1 June 1917	In command of School of Technical Training, AFC Training
11 August 1917	Attached to 24 th Training Squadron for instruction studies
1 October 1917	Detached from 24 th Training Squadron to 26th Training Squadron and transferred as 2 nd Air Mechanic
29 November 1917	Being graduated as a Flying Officer (pilot) appointed as Second Lieutenant and posted to 48 th
9-10 January 1918	Proceeded overseas to France. Marched into 4 th Squadron, 48 th
24 January 1918	Promoted Lieutenant
17 February 1918	Reported Missing in Action
10 August 1918	Reported Killed in Action on 17 February 1918 based on reporting from Germany
