Guillemont Road Cemetery

Created by flighting units in September 1916, the Commonwealth War Graves Commission's Guillemont Road Cemetery was used as a burial ground until March 1917. After the Armistice, it was expanded with the concentration of graves from the surrounding battlefields.
