Cherry, 26th Battalion, Australian Imperial Force, with a request that His Exeellency should make suitable arrangements for their presentation to the deceased officer's Father, Mr Cherry, Cradoc, Huon, Taspania.

Mr Cherry's residence in Tasmania would make it difficult for the Governor-General to personally present these decorations, and His Excellency suggests that he should ask the Governor of Tasmania to do so.

Before, however, adopting this course, the Governor-General will be glad to have the Prime Minister's views on the subject.
