Pozières British Cemetery

The Commonwealth War Graves Commission's Pozieres British Cemetery was beguin in July 1916 and was used until March 1918 when Pozieres was lost to German forces. The original burist carried out by flighting units and field original burist carried out by flighting units and field remaining plots were made after the Armistice when graves were brought in from the surrounding battlefelds. The four unidentified casualities being buried here today were all recovered nearby.
