Dear Madam,

With reference to the report of the regrettable loss of your son, the late No. 4913, Private S.A. Read, 46th (late 14th) Enttalion, I am now in receipt of advice which shows that he was killed in action in the field, France on 13th August, 1916, and buried at the Cemetery, Long Drive Valley, Albert. Map reference - X Sheet No. 57 D.E.E., Square No. X 11 A22- the Chaplain attached to the 12th Brigade officiating.

These additional details are furnished by direction, it being the policy of the Department to forward all information received in connection with deaths of members of the Australian Imperial Force.
