Lt.Kennedy was killed at Goose Alley - at the jumpidg off point at Flers about Nov.4 5th. He hadn't got five yds from the trench when he was killed by a bullet in the head. He was in the first wave, and I saw him lying dead as I went over with the second wave. He was buried on the tope of the trench just where he fell. The pioneers put up a cross over his grave and I have seen it.
