April, 1918 near SALLY-le-SEC, North of the SOIME River, this Officer carried out a minor operation skilfully and bravely in the face of great danger. He located an enemy post containing eight men which had been harassing our picket line for some days. He led his party in an excellent manner surrounded the post, killed two of the enemy and captured three, including the N.C.O. in charge.
