take evidence: -

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FIRST WITNESS:

Capt R.M.RANKING, R.A.M.C., states:-

No.8436 Dvr BLACK, George; 18th Battery A.F.A., was admitted to No.25 General Hospital on 8th September 1916 suffering from piles. He was transferred from No.3 Canadian General Hospital.

No.3 Canadian General Hospital.

On September 11th 1916 I operated on him for the above condition. After dilating the sphincter I siezed five internal piles with catch forceps and proceeded to deal with them by the legature operation. After having dealt with four of them by this method the anaesthetist informed me that the patient had stopped breathing. The patient was immediately released from the lithotomy position. The pupils were somewhat dilated and I could not feel his pulse. Artificial respiration was started immediately with the administration of oxygen, 10 minims of liquor strychnine were injected hypodermically, strong amonia administered by the nostrils, hot bottles applied to the extremities and hot applications over the heart. These methods were persisted in for an hour. I also opened the abdomen and performed massage of the heart. I considered Dvr BLACK to be in a fit state of health for the operation and all necessary care was taken in the preparation of the patient. The anaesthetist had given a good number of anaesthetics for me and always in a very competent manner.

SECOND WITNESS

Capt. R. W. ACHESON, R.A.M.C., states:-

On 11th September 1916 I administered an enaesthetic to Dvr BLACK. I induced anaesthesia with chloroform, using a Skinner's mask with a single layer of gauze. When the patient was completely under the influence of it, he showed slight difficulty in breathing, so I changed the anaesthetic to open ether, and adding a few drops of chloroform from time to time, and applied the tongue forceps. Dvr BLACK appeared to take this anaesthetic very well, when suddenly he ceased breathing; his pulse was still to be felt. I removed the mask and pulled the tongue forward and informed Capt Ranking that the patient had stopped breathing. The operation was immediately stopped and artificial respiration was started. Oxygen, strychnine, and amonia were administered, hot applications applied to the heart, the abdomen was also opened and the heart massaged.

Dvr BLACK was carefully examined by me prior to the operation and I considered him a suitable case for an anaesthetic. I have had considerable exterience in giving anaesthetics and this is the first occasion a patient has died while I have been giving the anaesthetic.

THIRD. WITNESS:

Capt Price JONES, R.A.M.C., states:-

I performed a post-mortem examination on the body of Dvr BLACK at 9.30 p.m. of the 11th September 1916, and found all the organs of the body healthy; there was no evidence of any pathological changes. There was no obvious cause of death.

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THE COURT, having considered the evidence, are of opinion that every reasonable precaution was taken before and during the administration of the anaesthetic, and that the anaesthetic was administered with skill and care. When respiration failed every possible endeavour was made to restore animation. The Court are of opinion that No.8436 Dvr BLACK George, 18th Battery, A.F.A., died of heart failure during the administration of anaesthetic, and that no blame can be attached to the anaethetist.
